OUTREACH GIVING

The year-to-date giving in 2022 by congregations in Alabama-Northwest Florida to the Disciples Mission Fund and the four Special Day Offerings {Easter, Pentecost, Thanksgiving, and Christmas) has increased by 2.29% compared to the November 2021, amount. REFUND POLICY


