Please send us this list so that we can have their voting status processed before they arrive. Also, we can send them the Business Documents if we receive the list in time.
2. Please provide opportunity for those who can't attend the Assembly to support it financially. The Assembly needs to pay for itself and this means that some additional support is needed beyond the registrations. This helps keep the registration cost low.
3. The Business Documents will be prepared after the Regional Committee on Recommendations meets on January 29. The Business Documents will be sent electronically and will be on the Region's web-site.
4. Special activities for youth and children are being planned for this assembly. Your help in promoting the assembly with your young people will be appreciated.

## ELECT LAY VOTING REPRESENTATIVES FOR REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

Each congregation in the Region is entitled to a minimum of four lay voting representatives (one of whom should be between the ages of 16 and 22) at the 2024 Regional Assembly on April 26 - 28, 2024, at Fairhope Christian Church, Fairhope, Alabama. All ministers with standing maintained through the Region are already voting representatives. The Regional Constitution provides for voting representatives in the following manner:

“Voting representatives from congregations.

- (1) Each congregation shall elect four voting representatives (one of whom should be between the ages of 16 and 22). Congregations with a participating membership of more than 200 shall elect one additional representative for each 100 participating members, or major fraction thereof, in excess of 200. The number of representatives shall be based upon reports submitted by congregations as published in the current Year Book and Directory of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). In the event a report was not received for that Year Book and Directory, the congregation may request voting privileges from the Regional Executive Committee. Each congregation shall notify the Regional Church office of the names and addresses of its voting representatives forty-five days before the opening of the Assembly. These voting representatives from congregations shall be in addition to persons having privilege to vote as ministers with standing.
- (2) Ministers serving or living in the Alabama-Northwest Florida Region who have ministerial standing and are listed in the current Year Book and Directory of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), or eligible for such listing, shall be voting representatives.
- (3) Members of the Regional Board and Regional Committee on Recommendations, not otherwise having voting privileges, shall be voting representatives.”

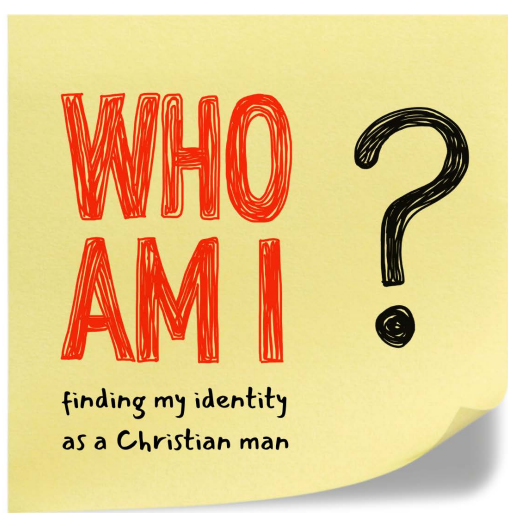

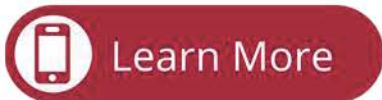

Have you ever experienced a process that shifted your world? What would it look like for members of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) to hear storytellers and engage our narratives? And what kind of church might we have if we imagined a narrative of a shared future?

***The Church Narrative Project aims to facilitate the collectively developed preferred narrative of the shared future of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).*** Through StoryHour gatherings followed by an ongoing series of engagements in the Transforming Community Conferencing process, the whole church will participate in a shared process of transformation in person and online not just learn about transformation. Through a facilitated process of interaction and dialogue led by Rev. Dr. David Anderson Hooker, the Church Narrative Project will engage participants in difficult and faithful work towards that aim.

The preferred narrative of our shared future is about who God is calling us to be in light of who we have been, who we are, and how we imagine we might meet God in the future given those two realities. It's about imagining a future by being honest about the stories that make us who we are as a church, and deciding together which stories to carry forward and which may not serve our shared future. The preferred narrative of the future will encompass the tenets of being anti-racist and pro-reconciling, and yet goes far beyond antiracism to state a positive and affirmative vision of the church as a result.

One of the guiding scriptures Dr. Hooker engages in the process is Luke 17:21 (NRSV) “nor will they say, ‘Look, here it is!’ or ‘There it is!’ For, in fact, the kingdom of God is among you.”

The process will answer a question of faithfulness: ***“When we as a church are manifesting the full power of our witness, who/what will we then be?”***
